

Birmingham City Council School Organisation Proposals

Enlargement to the Premises of a Foundation School by Expansion

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(2) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Birmingham City Council proposes to make a prescribed alteration, namely enlargement of the premises by expansion to Moor Hall Primary School, (a foundation school), Rowallan Road, Sutton Coldfield, West Midlands, B75 6RE with effect from 1st September 2017.

The current net capacity is 240. The proposed net capacity is 420.

The current admission number is 30. The proposed admission number is 60.

The school has taken up to an additional 30 places in Year 3 in September 2016 in temporary accommodation at the school site (these places have been included in the current net capacity figure).

Remodelling work is proposed on the existing accommodation and additional available land has been identified at the school site for the building of the extension to the school for the additional permanent classrooms and ancillary space required to implement the proposal.
