Our team from Acivico are in the final discussions with the BCC Planners to discharge the Pre-Commencement Planning Conditions. We expect these to be discharged by 29th December 2017.

Once complete it will be over to our construction partners, Balfour Beatty, to deliver the works.

There will be an opportunity for residents, parents, staff etc. to join our local Stakeholders Group which we will be setting up to meet from January.

A message from Balfour Beatty, the main Contractor:

Can we take this opportunity of introducing ourselves; we are Balfour Beatty Regional Construction Framework contractor working on behalf of Birmingham City Council's Education Infrastructure Department. The project comprises of the construction of a new two storey classroom building, a single storey extension to the existing hall and kitchen, cycle store and new staff car park.

The new two storey classroom building will accommodate;

- 7nr standard classrooms
- Resource room and breakout space
- 2nr male pupil and 2nr female pupil WC's
- 2nr disabled and 1nr staff WC's
- Storage and cleaners rooms
- Plant and server rooms

Works will commence in January 2018 and will be complete in Summer 2019. The school will remain fully functional during the building works.

Can we apologise in advance for any inadvertent disruption these works may cause, which we will endeavour to keep to an absolute minimum.
